Legislative

Sharon L. Robinson, P.E.

As stated in the State's Mid-Year Legislative Report "Although we were able to defeat all of the bills which posed real threats to the profession, our efforts to secure affirmative legislation to date have met with a good deal of frustration". Highlighted below is the status of some of the key pieces of legislation.

PASSED LEGISLATION

Illegal Practice (A8219/S4200)

Both houses have passed the bill to allow the State Education Department to include a 15% surcharge on our professional fees. The fees are to be used to civilly prosecute those engaged in the illegal practice of engineering.

Whistleblower Protection (A7144-A/S 5737)

This legislation further protects the employees who disclose illegal employer conduct.

PENDING LEGISLATION

Qualifications Based Selection (S3531-B/A 7056)

Although passed in the Assembly, the Senate still has not passed legislation that will require the use of Qualification Based Selection by Public Authorities and Public Benefit Corporations. The Metropolitan Transportation Authority opposes the legislation.

Bachelor's Degree (S4981-2008)

The legislation requires a Bachelor's Degree in order to be a PE. Opposition has come from the Public Employees' Federation Union.

DEFEATED (to date) LEGISLATION

Expansion of Exemptions to Engineering Licensure Requirement (S5487/A8257)

The legislation would provide for more exemptions of projects that would require services of design professionals. Currently, public works projects under \$5,000 and non-structural improvements to a building under \$10,000 are exempt; the proposal is to increase the thresholds to \$50,000. The society feels that only the professionals should design and review such projects for public safety, not building department officials and code enforcers.

Wastewater Treatment (S4821/A6031)

The legislation allows for designs of wastewater treatment plants of less than 1,500 gallons per day to be prepared by non-professional engineers.

MATHCOUNTS

Diego Villareale, P.E.

MATHCOUNTS is a national math enrichment, coaching and competition program that promotes middle school mathematics achievement. MATHCOUNTS challenges students' math skills, develops their self-confidence, motivates and rewards them for their achievements. Competitions are held locally, plus on the state and national levels. In recent surveys, 80% of state competition alumni reported scoring 1400 or higher on their SATs! Feel free to go to mathcounts.org at your convenience for more information on the national program.

The 2009/2010 competition will be held on Saturday, February 6, 2010 at Pace University. We are currently looking for volunteers to assist with proctoring of exams on the day of the event. Engineering EXPO 2010

This year's location will be at Tappan Zee High School in Rockland County on Sunday, March 21, 2010 from 11:00AM to 4:00PM. As you are aware, the main purpose of the EXPO is to introduce high school and middle school students to the world of engineering. Last year we had 40 engineering colleges, 11 professional organizations and 7 public agencies and 25 private firms. The attendance was tremendous. We estimated approximately 1,500 attendees at the function which consisted of students, parents and siblings. We will be searching for a guest speaker that will attract an audience. If you know of any candidates, please let us know.

The EXPO lasts for four hours with people arriving throughout the day. All of the engineering colleges/universities exhibit their promotions. We hope to have West Point Military Academy return with their a large staff to present and conduct their computerized bridge competition. In addition, we again will contact the Boy and Girl Scout troops to attend. They are required to ask questions and take notes in order for them to receive merit badges from their troops. We will also try to have robotics groups displaying their exhibits where the students interacted

with robot controls- the way of the future. The main purpose of getting the students involved with robotics is to inspire the student, and is a powerful program that helps students to discover the fun in science and technology while promoting team play and problem solving.

In addition, we plan to have PDH sessions for our members. EXPO is a very gratifying experience for all who attend and participate. Please save the date and we hope to see you there.

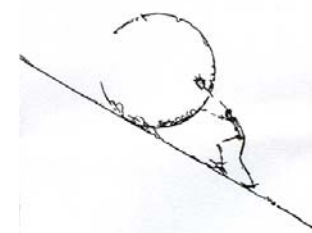

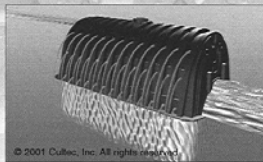
